



## Peter Day Driscoll, 84

WEST HARWICH — Peter Day Driscoll, 84, of West Harwich, formerly of Milton, died December 21, 2012, at St. Elizabeth's Medical Center in Boston after a period of failing health. He was the husband of the late Mary A. (McElaney) Driscoll.

Born in Boston on May 18, 1928, a son of the late Henry and Mary (Day) Driscoll, he was raised in Dorchester and was a graduate of Hyde Park High School and attended night school at Massachusetts Institute of Technology in Boston.

A veteran of WWII, he served in the U.S. Navy as a Seaman, Second Class and was an original crew member of the USS Leyte.
